Outings

Description/Purpose:

Monthly outings are designed to promote club fellowship and increase awareness and participation in the art of fly fishing. The outings should be fun and open to all members. One outing, the President's outing, should be a special outing restricted to members who have contributed in some way to CFFU. Outings should provide opportunities for CFFU members to apply the skills they acquired as part of the Technical Services Program and the Coachman Program.

Tasks and Activities:

1. Develop a general outing schedule and secure fishmeisters for the year with specific details on outings planned for the next six months.
2. Coordinate the schedule with the Programs Director and the Tech Thursday Director so that guest speakers can stimulate interest in the upcoming outings and provide information to the members on the fishery.
3. Provide copy of outings schedule with regular updates to the Webmaster and the Newsletter Editor.
4. Maintain an outings resource binder and pass it on to the next director.
5. Encourage Fishmeister to provide outings displays at the monthly meetings to encourage members to participate. The displays include maps and sign up sheets as a minimum.
6. Adjust outings schedules in case of events that would seriously impact the success of outing activities.
7. Where possible, encourage fishmeister to arrange for food at each outing.
8. Write or encourage the fishmeister to write a monthly article promoting the upcoming outing and write or encourage a person who attended the outing to write an article on the past outing.
9. Call fishmeisters to remind them of their responsibilities.
10. Encourage at least one long distance or out of state outing each year.
11. Act as fishmeister in the event you cannot secure one for the month.
